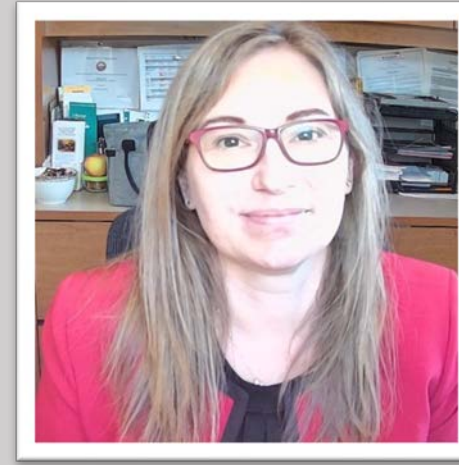

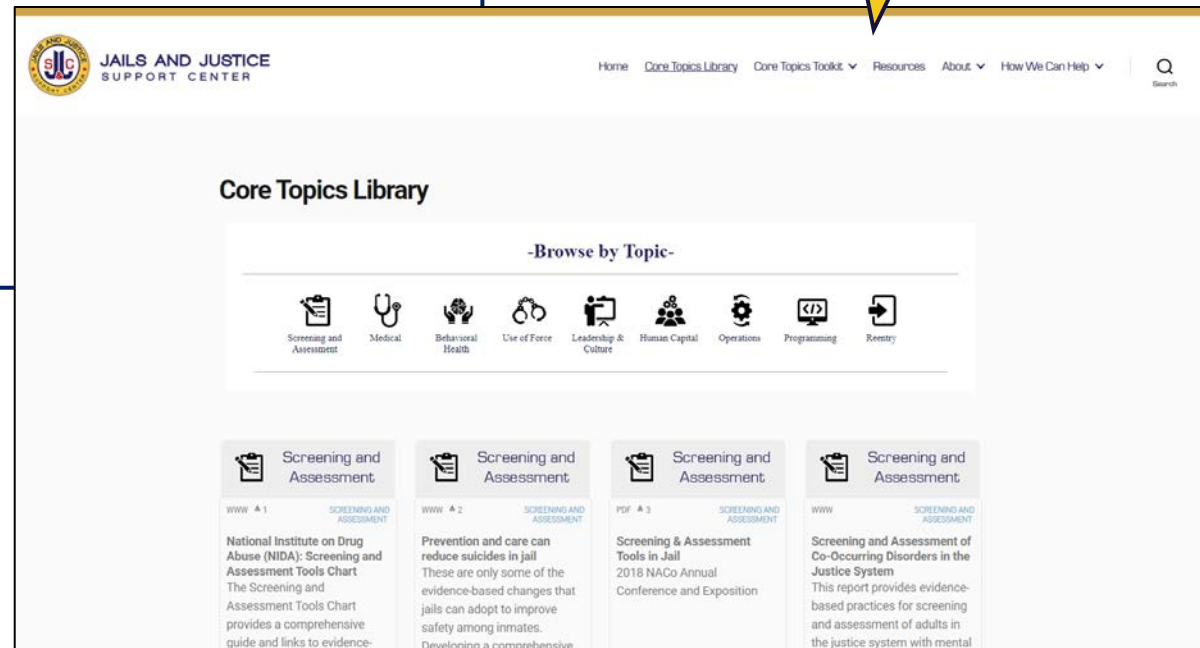



Technical Assistance Request Form

Technical assistance (TA) refers to the specialized guidance, assessment(s), or training(s) provided by a subject matter expert (SME) to a participating local or tribal agency (in most cases, a jail). The JJSC will work with agencies to provide customized TA related to the JJSC core topics or coordinate a direct referral from the JJSC to an existing provider to provide the service.

Initial sites will be selected in January 2024. All other TA requests are assessed to determine the appropriate assistance.

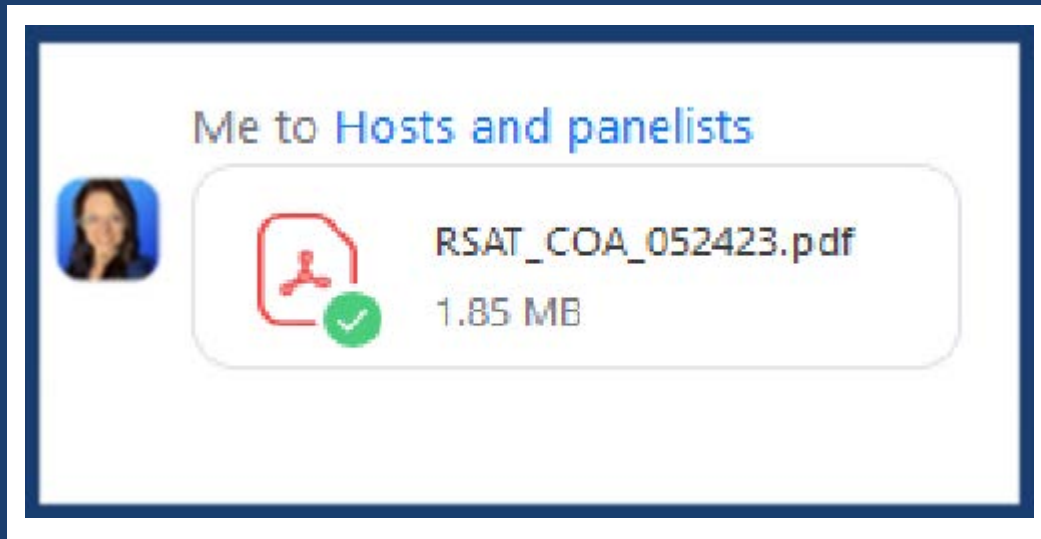

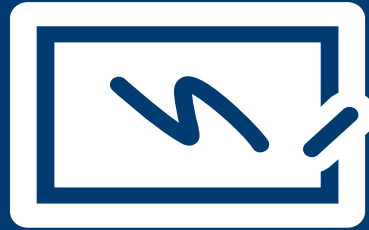
