Here's a way to assess how robustly you are implementing your program's cognitive behavioral therapy. Score your program on the *1 to 7* scales for each of the following questions. Better yet, have more than one person perform the ratings and average out the scores. If no question is rated lower than 4 and the total score is 35 or better, we would say you're doing quite well! If the program's total is less than 30, look for where and how it might be strengthened. We suggest assessing your program a few times a year.
